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Recently I was put onto the Swiss brand NORQAIN given their swift progress in the market. There is also no taper, which looks hilarious now that I'm reviewing the photos again. Bausele is the official watch of the centenary of the Royal Australian Air Force as well as several military corps and even the iconic Sydney Opera House. In a short period of time, they have established themselves as one of the most respected microbrands producing mechanical watches that enthusiasts love while supporting an active lifestyle. The dial itself is deep black and extends well into the case's extremities. Brand: BrewWatch Featured Above: MetricShop Their Collection Here One of the first microbrands that I connected with since starting my online journey with watches on my YouTube channel in 2017 was Brew. Orion makes no-nonsense tool watches that have fun 70s touch of color/style throughout. Highlighted here is the Bernina, a sports chronograph with a manual-winding movement and a fun colorway combo of red, white, and blue. CARE FOR METAL BRACELETS The bracelet should be cleaned occasionally by using a soft brush and warm soapy water, then rinsed thoroughly and dried completely. AnOrdain watches typically range from \$1,000-\$2,500, feature Swiss mechanical movements within, and are hand-assembled within the company's own facility. When it comes to watch consumers' interest, there has over the past several years been a rising level of interest in watch brands that deviate from what might be viable for the mass market luxury watch brands but appeal to a niche but passionate audience. His work typically focuses on the passage of time and the tools we use to connect with that very journey. Brand: FormexWatch Featured Above: REEFShop Their Collection Here Formex is one of those brands that are certainly on the cusp of being classified as an independent which I think you can make a strong argument for as they are producing some fantastic pieces for the money. Just look at the hand length pictured above. Brand: BalticWatch Featured Above: MROIShop Their Collection Here The past five years there has been a resurgence in the area of vintage watches. As a result, legibility is excellent and so are the proportions. First, it is important to classify for the sake of our list what a microbrand is and what it isn't. TEMPERATURE CARE Avoid temperature extremes. Since their initial launch into the market several years ago, they have expanded their lineup substantially, being a leader in the microbrand community from the land down under. When it comes to watches at an affordable price that nail this style, you are limited. As a member of Dartmouth Brands Ltd. CARE FOR STRAPS Salt residue and soil can be removed from leather or rubber (polyurethane) by cleaning with a dampened soft cloth and mild soap or saddle soap. Brand: Studio UnderDg Model featured above: Watermelon Chronograph London-based Studio UnderDg started out as the pet project of a restless University of Nottingham graduate, product designer Richard Benc, during 2020's COVID-19 lockdowns. Brand: VeroWatches Featured Above: Ridge TrailShop Their Collection Here Vero is a Portland, Oregon based microbrand that has carved out the casual west coast look with all their pieces that uphold a retro aesthetic. And for me, this watch didn't play well on other straps, which really did accent the 45mm case size in a bad way. William Wood Watches are offered with a choice of two different types of mechanical automatic movements, either a Japanese Seiko NH35 or, for a slight upcharge, a Swiss Sellita SW200. William Wood donates a percentage of the sales of each watch to firefighting charities, including the U.K.'s Fire Fighter Charity, which provides mental, physical and social support to the firefighting community, and the Australian Bushfire Relief Fund. Straton Watch was founded back in 2015 and has garnered up a reputation for developing watches with motorsport undertones. Once again, while that 52mm measurement might seem daunting, there is a fine degree of fluidity existing between lugs and the bracelet. The pieces I've seen on-hand have been impressive and the Freedom 60 GMT has standout potential. Recently, Formex has become increasingly popular as a result of their Essence of the Blog/YouTube sphere, and for good reason. The homage watch category can be a tricky tie rope to walk, but MKII has become very well respected in this space. Whether it's a watch for land, water, or air, this design language is prominent across each collection giving the brand a very distinct identity. In other words, Bulova made great use of the space provided by a 45mm case. Based in Rochester, New York, Ocean Crawler is a brand specializing in creating colorful, vintage-inspired dive watches with regulated Swiss Made movements. Brand: Oak & OscarWatch Featured Above: OlmstedShop Their Collection Here Back in early 2018, I was put onto Oak & Oscar for their clean and casual designed watches that fall in the \$1,000-\$2,500 price range. Swedish microbrand, Bravur, assembles all of their watches within their Stockholm facility with all of their pieces featuring Swiss movements and clean looks on the dial. I guess we should start by getting that all out in the open. Landing here as a spotlight piece is one of the latest offerings from the brands with the Helicat, offered in a handful of pleasing dial colors. Brand: Lum-TecWatch Featured Above: C7Shop Their Collection Here In the past few years, I have gotten the chance to know the guys at Lum-Tec as they are based locally by me. All the watches produced by the brand are hand-assembled and constructed by Cameron himself. Inside, the 262 kHz quartz movement is accurate to about 10 seconds per year and operates at a higher frequency than most common quartz movements. Swapping wasn't an option and now that I think of it, I wonder if it would have been worth it to just bead blast the bracelet somehow. With this considered, whenever I can spotlight someone who is aiming to keep alive the traditions of watch production then I am eager to do it. Looking at the case from the side, we really get a sense of how playful the case architecture is, with its large cylindrical bezel and a tall box sapphire crystal. Each one extends adequately to its corresponding track, whether it's the small white batons in the sub-dials or the primary hour and minute hands. Their watches follow a similar styling ethos of utilizing striking colors while containing reliable mechanical movements within. Brand: BravurWatch Featured Above: DW003Shop Their Collection Here Similar to the trend of having vintage-inspired designs, the same can be said for that of watches that have minimalist aesthetics, which brings us to our next brand: Unimatic. has quickly become an archetype for how a small upstart brand can get more mass-market attention through quality design from the high-level brand experience down to the products they create. Shortly after, the honeymoon phase died down, the watch was sold, and now, it's on my mind again (the newer, all-black model) so I'm taking some time evaluate what Bulova is offering here. You also get 200m of water resistance and an extra suede strap that can be quickly and easily swapped out with the installed bracelet. It's a big, really easy to read, and text is kept to a minimum—no complaints here. It's my understanding that there are some differences in case architecture between this version and the one that comes with the faux carbon fiber looking strap. Positioned at the top of the collection are hand engraved cases that are of extremely limited production. Brand: Deep BlueWatch Featured Above: Diver 1000mShop Their Collection Here Deep Blue got their start back in 2007 and has become one of the fastest-growing micros in the world of divers. If you want more insight into the mind of their designs I discussed this in greater detail with Jonathan back in 2018 at a local NYC park. This brand is a nice option for the heavy dive watch enthusiasts that wants a variety of different dial colors and case styles to choose from. Brand: Astor BanksWatch Featured Above: FortitudeShop Their Collection Here Chicago-based microbrand Astor Banks was founded by watch lover Andrew Perez and has quickly carved out a niche creating some very attractive looking mechanical tool watches. For now though, let's get into the specifics of the first generation Bulova Lunar Pilot Chronograph. Brand: Massena LABWatch Featured Above: Uni-RacerShop Their Collection Here Chicago Here Massena LAB is the brainchild of prominent industry personality William Massena. Learn more by visiting Bulova's official site and check out our Bulova Watches history and resource page. This brand was started back in 2016 and now is one of the best fastest growing mechanical watch brands. Brand: HegidShop Their Collection Here Every brand's marketing strategy attempts to position itself as a unique product in the marketplace. Most notably, they all feature a U.S.-made movement, namely the "Ameriguartz" caliber 70200, a quartz caliber developed and produced by Fine Timepieces Solutions (FTS) in Fountain Hills, Arizona that carries a five-year warranty. In 2021, for the 20th anniversary of the 9/11 terror attacks, William Wood partnered with the Tunnel to Towers Foundation to auction off a unique edition of its Triumph Heat chronograph model to benefit the charitable organization, which raised \$19,000 after an opening bid of \$2,000. This is one of the nicest bracelets you can get in this price range and it's a shame that it looks like some kind of bad aftermarket mix-up. They first jumped on the scene with the release of the Neptune and following up with other favorites like the Falcon which I have reviewed on my channel. Brand: MontaWatch Featured Above: NobleShop Their Collection Here Monta is a small brand based out of St. Louis Missouri here in the US has quickly risen in the ranks with developing a great reputation for producing some of the better quality watches that really are in that upper echelon of microbrands that I mentioned earlier. This is quite a flattering claim, but there is a lot of truth to it given their quick movement of inventory and demand for models that you can't have. Hegid has been one of the more interesting brand concepts we've seen in recent years Brand: LaventureWatch Featured Above: Sous-MarineShop Their Collection Here Laventure is a Neuchâtel, Switzerland-based microbrand that creates impressively constructed timepieces for adventurers in limited series. Founded in 2015 by former banking professional Francois Moreau, Reservoir brings a visually unique approach to displaying dial information. However, Hamburg upstart brand Sternglas is perhaps the best for out there to fit this category. The marrying of watches and cars seem to be a match made in heaven given the mechanical undertones of both. Currently, the Uni-Racer collection consists of reasonably sized 39mm models in a handful of sharp and interesting colorways and supplied with reliable Swiss Sellita movements. From aviation to music and travel, his interests span a multitude of disciplines that often intersect with the world of watches - and the obsessive culture behind collecting them. The Case At 45mm wide, a great deal of folks were doubtful when the 'Bulova Moon Watch' was first announced. Reservoir calls La Chaux-de-Fonds their home and uses high-quality Swiss movements to pair with their signature designs. The Dial In my eyes this is the part of the watch that's executed perfectly. Brew tends to be a little bit slower to release new products, however, whenever it does happen it is usually always a hit and quickly leads to selling out in a short manner. It just seems unnecessarily large but like all watches, you can never really tell if it'll work for you until you get it on wrist. That's mostly what attracted me initially and it really takes the whole grab-and-go quartz concept to a new level. 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
